


First UD Leg!

Carol and Bently are very excited to start getting involved in therapy work!








Have you heard of "A New Leash on Life"?

"A New Leash on Life" is a North Carolina program that allows minimum and medium custody state prisons to partner with local animal shelters, animal welfare agencies, and/or private non-profit agencies to train dogs in preparation for their adoption. In turn, the inmates are given a chance to serve the community by training dogs to be well-behaved pets.

Selected dogs are placed with inmate trainers in a prison setting for eight to twelve weeks. The inmates teach basic obedience, house training, and socialization through positive reinforcement and repetition. Dogs are taught to walk on and off the leash and to respond to basic commands.

Each prison facility partners with a local partner or sponsor, a volunteer animal trainer, and local merchants or civic organizations that can support the program with needed supplies and services.

There are currently two apprenticeship programs offered to inmates in the New Leash on Life program. In these programs inmates have the opportunity to receive certified training that will help them obtain a job upon their release from prison. To obtain apprentice certification through the Department of Labor, an inmate must complete 4000 hours on the job training as well as a total of 288 hours related instruction. The related instruction is either provided through the community college or the volunteer trainer. The first apprenticeship is a Dog Trainer



Apprenticeship that began in 2007 at Craven CI and has since expanded to include Eastern CI. The second is an Animal Care Provider Apprenticeship and will begin in 2009 at Brown Creek CI and will allow inmates to complete the on the job training at any of the New Leash on Life facilities.

Barn Hunt???

Not everyone will understand the importance of "rat catchers," but if you live in the countryside, you sure do! "Rat catchers" rid farms of destructive vermin – and the hunting and teamwork skills required to do so are the foundation of the sport of Barn Hunt. Dogs and their handlers work as a team to locate and mark rats (which are always safely held in aerated tubes) hidden in a maze of straw or hay bales.

Some breeds are specifically created to fill this role as well as some mixed breeds being up to the task, but as long as your dog can fit through an 18" wide by bale-height tall tunnel, he's eligible! "Barn Hunt tests the nose, speed, agility, and surefootedness of dogs that have a history of above-ground vermin hunting," Said Robin Nuttall, founder of the Barn Hunt Association."

Barn Hunt events include a pass/fail instinct class for owners who want to familiarize their dog with the test. Courses are made increasingly difficult by adding more obstacles, additional diversions and more rats to find. There are several types of Barn Hunt titles your dog can earn:

Novice Barn Hunt (RATN),
Senior Barn Hunt (RATS),
Barn Hunt Champion (RATCh),
Crazy 8s Bronze (CZ8B),
Crazy 8s Gold (CZ8G),

Open Barn Hunt (RATO),





To prove that it's her incredible skill as a trainer and not just one awesome dog, Paula then put an OTCH on her Bluetick, Suzie.

I asked Paula how she got interested in competition. She said, "When I was training Jeb for his CGC, I watched people training for competition, and I said I'd never do that. I wasn't interested in precision. As I trained to be a professional trainer, the trainers teaching me never limited my dogs based on their breed. I started teaching Jeb all kinds of things, and with that came confidence. When Blueticks were recognized by the AKC, I decided to show for a CD. That was January 2005, I think. The rest is history".

Paula has owned several breeds but always wanted a Bluetick Hound and Jeb was her first. She started him in search and rescue. He did multiple disciplines and had a very successful career.
