To shape or not to shape for competition obedience

Shaping, a training method where you break down one behavior into numerous successive little steps, is not always a good thing for competition-obedience dogs because they learn that if they get no feedback, they need to try something else. We create popcorn dogs who learn that silence means they need to offer something. And they learn that when there is no click, or no feedback, they've done something wrong. Given that our sport is a silent one, and we have to compete in silence, we should be very careful of communicating that silence means you did it wrong. Or, we have taught that competition means you did it wrong.

We've all had someone give us the "silent treatment." According to them, everything is "fine," but meanwhile you have to guess which possible sin you've committed, and figure out how to make it right without ever being told what you've done. This is extremely frustrating. When you are with these people, you feel like you are walking on eggshells and are never quite sure what's expected of you. Be mindful with clicker games so that you don't allow the silence to become stressful for your dog. While there are many dogs who do not respond this way, there are still many shaped dogs who really suffer from undue stress when put in the obedience or rally ring.

Make sure the tool is right for your dog. And make sure that you never ever teach your dog that silence means she is wrong.



Is your dog enjoying his work?

Some think it's ok to train a young dog an aspect of work that he doesn't enjoy, as long as they follow it up with a type of work he likes—instead of recognizing that the problem isn't the dogs lack of keenness for a new concept, rather it's with the method/handler not making the training enjoyable.

While being insistent might work for dogs that have high drive at a young age, for many others, it's too much pressure, too soon, and can have detrimental consequences. Trainers that make lots of corrections with young dogs, including not letting them be tight, fast, etc. often believe their dogs should "push through" training, even if their body language and demeanor isn't keen for the work, usually in an effort to accelerate the training. The problem with this is, you cannot recreate initial enthusiasm. For some dogs, the resentment for the phase of work that was forced upon them, stays with them and could have been avoided if the handler had changed their training approach or method.

If you try to shape or push your young dog and he gets reluctant, sniffs, is master conscious, turns tail or comes back to you for reassurance, etc.. he's telling you that you're spoiling his enjoyment. It's his way of letting you know he's not ready for the pressure you're applying. It's not normal or acceptable that a dog should quit working. Handlers may blame their dog rather than recognizing something about their training has a bullying mindset rather than a teaching mindset. While many dogs can't accept being pushed at a young age, with patience, those same dogs can have great accomplishments and we've trained countless dogs that were labeled by others as 'not keen enough' to train or too immature. Watch your dogs body language and demeanor. If he's not enjoying what he's doing, he's probably not ready for the next step and/or he needs you to change your approach. Once he is enthusiastic and confident, try the next step and make adjustments based on his response. Take the time it takes, to be certain your dog fully understands and enjoys a new training concept before you set expectations. Patience empowers your dogs confidence and development.



The Veterinary Magic of the Middle Ages

Medieval healers treated animals' ailments with a mix of faith, tradition and science By John Last, Smithsonian Magazine

The year is 1266, and your horse is acting strange. It started with a fever. But then weeping pustules appeared all over its body, and fluids poured forth from every orifice. Not long after, the horse stabled next to it came down with the same sickness. You've heard of this before. It's the dreaded disease called farcy—and you'll need more than medicine to make your animals well again.

When creatures like these hapless horses fell ill, medieval peasants and nobles alike relied on the occult powers of animal healers, forerunners to today's veterinarians. Employing magic words and rituals alongside early medicines, these horse doctors and hound charmers faced down the most incurable of diseases with a combination of faith, tradition and science. Often at odds in the modern mind, the boundaries between these elements of everyday life were far more ambiguous during the Middle Ages; defined by medievalist Kathryn Walton as "actions that medieval people took to influence their world in some way," magic was just another option in a healer's toolbox.




